His Stars & Stripes is the newest division of HLOM. The mission focuses on the needs of the children of active duty military personnel, children that have lost parents while they were serving active duty and children of parents that come back from war different spiritually, physically, mentally or emotionally.

The division currently provides counseling services and care packages that are specially designed to comfort and encourage each child. The packages include the books, "My Daddy Wore A Uniform" or "My Mommy Wore A Uniform"; "Sharing

Jesus With Children Around the World" booklet; "Plant The Word Scripture Cards"; a stuffed animal, K.Y.E.O.J. bracelet and a personally signed card from the His Stars & Stripes Prayer Team.


Ministry prayer teams are available to pray for each child and family upon receiving their request.



written by Lynne Robertson O'Quinn & Illustrated by Jeffery Duckworth. When O'Quinn was asked about her inspiration behind these books, she responded: "I saw a need for books such as these to bring comfort, hope, healing, understanding and pride to these children. As a child, I witnessed my own friends lose parents and as an adult I have witnessed friends who have had a loved one come back different or they themselves have returned different, whether it be

physically or mentally. All my life I have witnessed the many sacrifices our armed forces make for America so we can enjoy freedom. I pray these books will bring peace to the children and that they will carry a huge amount of pride for their parents who sacrificed so much for us all. May we never forget, these children are truly all our heroes." Military chaplains said the books are filling a major void for the many children that are struggling in these areas.
